Borgo Antico

One of the oldest surviving spiritual hearts of the region, built from the very stone of the mountain itself.



Monforte Castle

The crown jewel and highest point of the city, dominating the skyline and offering breathtaking views of the Molise landscape.

The Living Statues: Sagra dei Misteri

The Visionary

Engineered by Paolo Saverio Di Zinno, an 18th-century local sculptor who merged faith with brilliant mechanical design.



The Spectacle

Real people are suspended in mid-air. Hidden flexible steel branches support their weight, creating flying "living statues" that blend theater and community spirit.

The Legacy

Housed in the Museo dei Misteri, these unique mechanical wonders are preserved, maintained, and celebrated by the city year-round.

Cavatelli

The handmade, historically rooted pasta that defines the region's rustic tables and agricultural heritage.



Pizza di Grandinia

The iconic teardrop-shaped cheese, a direct reflection of the pastoral mastery and sheep-farming traditions of the high mountains.
